

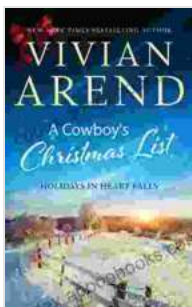
Cowboy Christmas List: A Heartwarming Holiday Story in Heart Falls

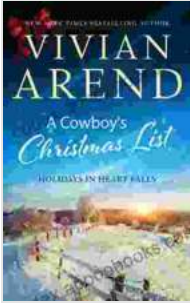

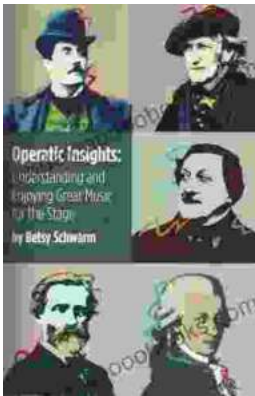
