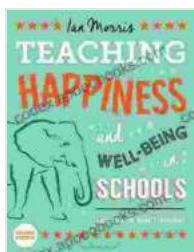


Learning to Ride Elephants

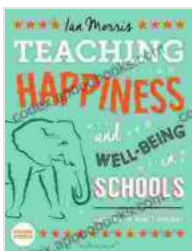

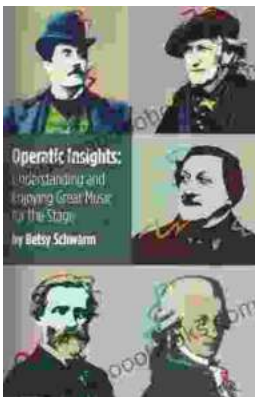
