1. Water Balloon Dodgeball



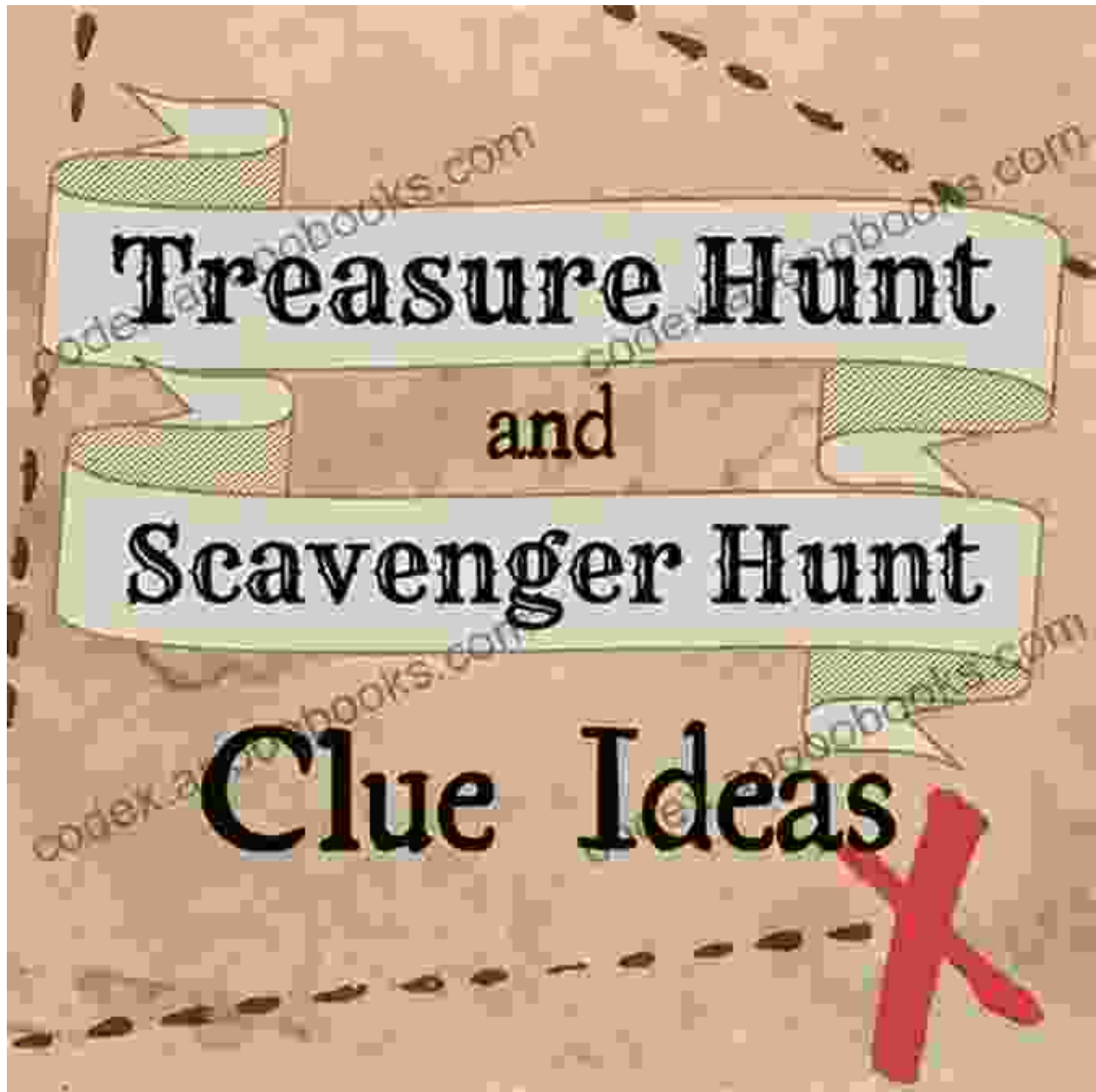

10. Water Race Relay

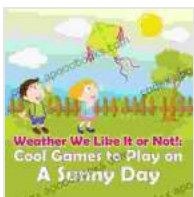

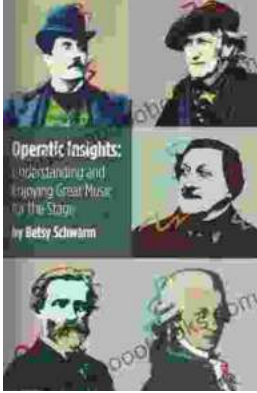
